Herricks is located 20 miles east of Manhattan. The school district is comprised of residents who live in parts of the villages of Albertson, Manhasset Hills, New Hyde Park, Roslyn, Roslyn Heights and Williston Park. The district includes three elementary schools (K-5), a middle school (6-8) and a high school (9-12), as well as the Shelter Rock Academy alternative school program.

Overall enrollment for grades K-12 is 4,000 students and 380 teachers.
