

MYSTERY READER EXPECTATIONS

- When volunteering to be a VIRTUAL mystery reader in your child's class, please keep in mind the following:
 - Please provide 3 clues about yourself. Be sure they aren't too obvious.
 Here is a sample set of clues written by a parent last year.
 - 1. My favorite book when I was in Kindergarten was Mrs. Wishy Washy.
 - 2. My family has one dog as a pet.
 - 3. I love to watch movies with my family.
 Kindly email or put a note in your child's folder prior to your assigned day/time.
 - Please be on time for the day/time you signed up for.
 - Choose a school-age/grade level appropriate book. If you need ideas, I have included links to grade appropriate books on the last page of this document.
 - Be sure students can see the pages of the book and hear you clearly.
 - Email me the name of the book that you plan on sharing....just want to be sure you don't choose the same book as another reader!
- I will share the clues with the class prior to your reading, SO...when you are introduced, remember to announce who you are. You are welcome to be creative-- such as bringing a puppet, wear a costume, bring your pets, use a unique voice, etc...
- Most importantly...HAVE FUN!
