Required Course List: Students must take one of the following **two** courses:

World History 9 = 1 Credit

Part one in a two-year study of the major themes and movements that have shaped our world, World History 9 covers the first civilizations to 1750. Special attention is paid to the cultivation of advanced reading, writing and research skills.

Global History and Geography 9 = 1 Credit

This course is the first year in a two-year study of Global History and explores the major events and movements that shaped the world from the first civilizations through 1750. With a focus on the development of reading and writing skills, and smaller class sizes, the course provides extra support to students who have struggled with Social Studies in the past.

Elective Course List:

Students may take *as many* of the following courses as they please.

- **Advanced Placement Human Geography = 1 Credit**
- **Independent Research I, II and III = ½ Credit per course**
- **Model United Nations/Int'l Studies I, II & III = ½ Credit per course**
- **News Literacy = ½ Credit**
- **Philosophy I (Intro to Philosophy) = ½ Credit**
- **Racial Literacy in Society = ½ Credit**
- **United States History Through Film = ½ Credit**
- **World History Through Film = ½ Credit**
- **World History Workshop = ½ Credit**
