

Board of Education Notes January 11, 2024 Meeting

In an effort to increase Board/Public Communications, after each Board of Education meeting an email will be sent to parents, staff, and anyone who requested to receive district e-mail communications, highlighting board discussions.

- The meeting opened with a ribbon cutting ceremony for the newly renovated Community Center Auditorium, which will have its innaugural event on January 19th with the Middle School's presentation of *The Wizard of Oz* musical. The high school's student representatives discussed the upcoming Winter Ball, Harlem Wizards, and Youth Against Cancer events. Dr. Sinanis reminded students and staff to remain mindful of the many respiratory illnesses going around, urging people to stay home if they're sick to avoid spreading illness. Last week saw the Middle School host a Chopped Jr. event—which the kids did a great job with—as well as the PTA District Council meeting, which went well. Finally, four Herricks students were named as Regeneron Science Talent Search Scholars and will be recognized by the district at the January 25th Board of Education meeting.
- There was an Audit Committee Presentation regarding the 2022-2023 school year by a claims auditor. Herricks was announced as having a less than 1% error rate, which was made to be effectively zero with the aid of timely corrections.
